— What is a Risk Assessment? —

A Risk Assessment is a comprehensive consultation with a registered nurse who is specially trained to determine your risk for developing breast cancer. The nurse will evaluate several risk factors and provide a customized breast care plan for you. The nurse may recommend more frequent screenings, Automated Whole Breast Ultrasound, Breast MRI, or optional genetic testing.



Why is a Risk Assessment important for me and my family?

Early detection is one of the best things you can do to increase your chances of preventing or surviving breast cancer. A Risk Assessment provides crucial information about how often and what type of screenings you need. Determining your risk factors can help your children, siblings, and other family members become aware of their risk and take charge of their own breast health.

How can I prepare for my Risk Assessment appointment?

Before your Risk Assessment appointment, gather information about family members on your mother's and father's sides that have had a cancer diagnosis—especially breast or ovarian cancer. Find out where their cancer started and how old they were when they received their cancer diagnosis.
